Problem	Options
Bio-identical hormone replacement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Bio-identical hormones in custom strengths and dosage forms, i.e. topical creams, vaginal suppositories, sublingual troches, and oral sustained-release capsules.</li> <li>▪ Private patient evaluations and consultations by pharmacist and saliva testing are also available.</li> </ul>
Vaginal Dryness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Estriol vaginal cream; testosterone cream (local vaginal area usage)</li> </ul>
Infertility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Progesterone injection (peanut oil free), vaginal suppositories, troches</li> </ul>
Inability to reach orgasm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Zen cream (Aminophylline 3%-Arginine 6%-Papaverine 0.1%)</li> </ul>
Prevention of Preterm Labor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 17-Hydroxyprogesterone caproate oil for Injection</li> </ul>
Vulvodynia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Ketamine &amp;/or Bupivacaine cream</li> <li>▪ Amitriptyline topical gel</li> <li>▪ Gabapentin topical</li> <li>▪ Atropine ointment</li> <li>▪ Clonidine 0.1%</li> <li>▪ Neuropathic pain gels or Combinations of above</li> </ul>
Loss of Libido	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Testosterone vaginal or topical cream (local vaginal area usage)</li> </ul>
Vaginal Warts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Topical antiviral, i.e. deoxy-d-glucose (DDG) or cimetidine</li> <li>▪ Trichloroacetic acid (TCA) solutions or gels.</li> </ul>
PMS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Progesterone capsules, transdermal cream</li> </ul>
Hemorrhoids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Hydrocortisone-Lidocaine, rectal rocket with lidocaine jelly</li> </ul>
Lichen Sclerosis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Testosterone/Corticosteroid creams</li> </ul>
Vaginal bacterial or fungal infections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Antibiotic or antifungal agents in various dosage forms and strengths, i.e., vaginal suppositories, creams, capsules, gels.</li> <li>▪ Boric acid vaginal capsules.</li> <li>▪ Acidophilus vaginal cream</li> </ul>
Morning Sickness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ B6 transdermal gel</li> <li>▪ Ginger-apple spice troche</li> </ul>
Office Use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Potassium hydroxide</li> <li>▪ Gentian violet</li> <li>▪ Trichloroacetic acid (TCA)</li> <li>▪ Cantharidin and Cantharadin plus</li> </ul>
