Erectile Dysfunction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Prostaglandin, Papaverine, Phentolamine Combination Injection (can add Atropine as well) ▪ Prostaglandin Inserts (Alprostadil) ▪ Sildenafil: Troches, Rapid Dissolve Tablets ▪ Testosterone: Gel, Cream, Troche, Pellet, Injection ▪ Prostaglandin & Yohimbe Gel ▪ Isosorbide Dinitrate, Aminophylline, Ergoloid Mesylate Combination Cream
